Described by Governor Darling as 'a woman of extraordinary bodily strength and energy of character', Elizabeth Fulloon was a 43-year-old recently widowed mother of five when she arrived in NSW to take up her role as Superintendent of the Parramatta Female Factory in May 1824. Her term was short, but is remembered for culminating in the infamous 'Factory riot' of October 1827.

How did the wife of a London schoolmaster find herself appointed as the first female Superintendent at Parramatta? How should we remember her time at the Factory? And did her actions really lead to the riot?

Heather Garnsey is a direct descendant of Elizabeth Fulloon. Best known for her work as the Executive Officer of the Society of Australian Genealogists for 35 years, Heather has spoken at seminars and conferences throughout Australia. She was recognised with the AFFHO Award for Meritorious Service to Family History in 2015 and is an Honorary Member and Fellow of the SAG. After retiring in February 2020 she is enjoying having time to research her own family history.




