Queensland Registry of Births Deaths and Marriages – have introduced a new ID system for online users. If you have previously purchased a certificate from them, you will have an account. You will therefore have been issued with an QDI (Queensland Digital Identity) based on your email address. If you

are only searching the BDM index but not purchasing this does not apply. The QDI is only for viewing previous purchases or making new ones.
